TAYLOR CENTRE FOR PERFORMING ARTS HONOURED BY ALBERTA CONSTRUCTION MAGAZINE AS THE TOP PROJECT OF THE YEAR

Calgary, Alta. - December 10, 2015 - The Taylor Centre for Performing Arts was honoured by Alberta Construction Magazine as one of the Top Projects of the year in Alberta. The project was awarded **Top Institutional Project over \$50M**, as well as the highest honour of **Top Project of The Year**.

The new Taylor Centre for Performing Arts, which houses Mount Royal University's Conservatory and Bella Concert Hall, is a unique and one of a kind facility constructed in the heart of the campus. This complex facility features a number of custom components that make the building one of the premier theatrical and teaching spaces in North America. From the shape and structure, to the acoustics and the finishes- no part of this project was conventional.

The facility is sculpted around the central Bella Concert Hall, named after Mary Belle Taylor of Calgary's own Taylor family. The Bella Concert Hall itself is unique, featuring highly advanced acoustics, theatrical lighting, intricate steel mesh installations and custom rose shaped wood and steel acoustic reflectors suspended from the ceiling.
